## Cochrane Snakes and Ladders - Editorial process for protocols and reviews -

START You submit a draft manuscript* to the editorial base – go to 2	The editorial base thinks that the manuscript meets our standards – go to 3 OR The manuscript needs further revisions – return to 1	Your manuscript protocol is sent to peer-review. This involves: 1-2 consumer referees, 1-2 clinical editors/referees, and 1 statistical editor/reviewer – go to 4	You wait for 3-4 weeks (protocol) or 4-6 weeks (review) while your manuscript is at peerreview – go to 5
The editorial base collates and checks peer-reviewer comments (e.g. for contradictory or contentious points) – go to 6	You receive peer- reviewer comments & no revisions are required! - Go to 10 OR You need to respond to all peer-reviewer comments & revise the manuscript – go to 7	The editorial base returns your revised manuscript & response to peer-reviewers – go to 8	Peer-reviewers are happy with the revisions – go to 10 OR Peer-reviewers aren't happy with the revisions – go to 9
You revise and resubmit your manuscript - return to 8  NB there is a limit to the number of times your manuscript can be resubmitted, and it may be rejected	The Co-ordinating Editors & Statistical Editor peruse your manuscript – go to 11	You wait for 2 to 3 weeks (for protocol and review) – go to 12	The Co-ordinating Editor & Statistical Editor approve the manuscript – go to 13 OR They ask for minor revisions – return to 9
The manuscript is sent to Wiley Copy-editors - go to 14	You wait 2-3 weeks (protocol) or 3-4 weeks (review) – go to 15	You peruse Wiley Copy-editor remarks & amend your manuscript if necessary – go 16	16 CONGRATULATIONS - your manuscript is published!
